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Downingtown Area Recreation Consortium PLAYER CONDUCT CODE

Players, coaches, managers, or other team members will not make disparaging or insulting remarks to or about opposing players, officials, or spectators or commit other acts (e.g. profane or abusive language, taunting, etc.) that could be considered unsportsmanlike conduct. Hostile behavior will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

If we suspect that any players come to the field intoxicated we will not permit them to play. If you act disrespectful or argue with an umpire or any league official, you will be suspended. We will stop a game if necessary. The entire team will be suspended...you are responsible for the actions of all the players on your team.

Any player, manager or coach who is ejected from a game for any of the above offenses must leave the playing area immediately. The DARC Ejection Policy for all league participants will be as follows:

1st Offense: If any player, manager, or coach is ejected from a game he/she will be suspended for at least one game. He/she must leave the playing area immediately and will not be permitted to participate in the next game (and possibly more, depending on the infraction).

2nd Offense: The second infraction will result in a suspension of at least two (2) games and he/she will not be permitted to participate in any playoff or championship games.

3rd Offense: The third infraction will result in the player, manager, or coach being permanently dismissed from the team for the remainder of the season without refund. He/she will not be permitted to participate in any DARC leagues for at least one year from the date of the third infraction.

Threats of any kind, either to a player or officials will result in a minimum two (2) year league suspension. This is a serious violation and the local authorities will be notified. If you act disrespectful or argue with an umpire or any league official, you will be suspended. Further action will be taken for any physical contact or incidents which may warrant additional suspension or discipline.

By registering your team for this season, you and your teammates understand and will abide by the guidelines listed above. Any team that violates the player conduct code may be removed from the league without refund. As a team captain, you are responsible for the members of your team, and will be held accountable for the actions of your team members.
