



#### **REGISTRATIONS:**

You can begin to register for activities as soon as you receive your brochure. Registrations are open until an activity reaches maximum capacity. All registrations are taken on a first come first served basis. Please register at least 72 hours prior to the start of the activity—you could be the difference whether or not an activity will run. Decisions on any necessary activity cancellations (due to lack of enrollment) are generally made at least 72 hours prior to the activity start date.
